Foundations in Disordered Gambling

Foundations in Disordered Gambling is a two day training intended for clinicians who are new to disordered gambling. This training will increase the participants knowledge and understanding of the disease of gambling addiction and prepare the practicing clinician to work with problem and pathological gamblers and their families.

Treating the Disordered Gambler

Presenter: Dr. Heather Chapman, Ph. D., NCGC-II-BACC

Treating the Disordered Gambler is a two day training that will provide clinicians with 12 hours of gambling specific education. This phase of training was designed for the clinician preparing to treat disordered gamblers. During this training, clinicians will gain a better understanding of treating gambling addiction through Cognitive Behavioral Therapy and Motivational Interviewing techniques. Participants will discuss case reviews, participate in role plays, and write treatment plans. Participants will also discuss disordered gambling as a co-occurring disorder.

Prerequisite: Foundations in Disordered Gambling or previous gambling counseling training

Advanced Disordered Gambling Training

In this two day training, participants will gain advanced knowledge regarding treating disordered gamblers. This training is designed for the advanced clinician preparing for the gambling certification credential. This training will provide the required 3 hours of ethics needed to obtain the gambling credential, and participants will learn skills for working with gamblers and their families. This workshop will contain detailed information about the co-occurring disorders associated with gambling, as well as the subtypes used to classify disordered gamblers.

Prerequisite: Treating the Disordered Gambler or 24 hours of gambling counseling training

Gambling Prevention Education

Participants will learn common prevention theories such as risk and protective factors and the developmental assets as they relate to disordered gambling, and will explore how gambling education can be integrated into prevention programming. No prerequisite required.
